Background and Methodology

- <u>The purpose</u>: to understand some of the features and online services that members of futureproducers.com could benefit from. Based on the results of the survey we will commence new developments.
- Created on limewire.com and collected online.
- Survey distributed via forum announcements and email invitation to members.
- 12 questions. All optional.
- Survey launched Dec 28, 2010 and closed Jan 24, 2011.
- Total records in survey <u>1,206</u> respondents.
- Survey anonymous.





Research Findings: Part 1

A Little About Yourself

I am a hobbist- this is my side interest and I am not so bad! (B)	29.68%
I spend a considerable amount of time on my music; high skill level (C)	36.07%
Music is my profession. I earn my living with my music/music making skills (D)	19.24%

- Paper books, magazines, newspapers: 57%
- Online forums: 80%
- Online social networks: 42% (more than HR 26%)
- Online editorial magazines: 52%
- TV & DVDs: 31%
- Professional Trade Shows & Conferences: 31%
- Other musicians, producers, colleagues: 76%
- Retails: 26%

Online Presence & Community Needs

When it comes to content about gear or recording techniques I prefer: (Strongly Agree + Agree %)

- Editorial content (Articles/reviews/videos): 74%
- Short News Items: 37% (and 30% neutral)
- User generated content (articles/reviews/videos): 72%
- Online discussions (e.g. forums, facebook groups): 64%
- Gear manufacturer's info on their website: 56%



On a scale of 1-5 (5 being most important) how important are the following aspects for you in an online community when looking to join a forum: (5 + 4 %)

- Expertise in subject matter: 68%
- Friendliness: 58%
- Willingness to help: 68%
- Respect for other members: 63%
- Adherence to forum rules & regulations: 45%
- Ability to promote my music/beats: 29%



The reason I visit Futureproducers is to: (Strongly Agree + Agree %)

- Improve my knowledge and skill level: 81%
- Promote my music: 27%
- Discover new music: 40%
- Help other members by giving advice/answering questions: 54%
- Meet other musicians/producers for musical projects: 50%



By interacting with other members on Futureproducers I have: (Strongly Agree + Agree %)

- Improved my knowledge and skill level: 62%
- Made several online friends: 25%
- Discovered new music: 37%
- Found other musicians/producers for musical projects: 28%
- Increased awareness/promotion for my music: 30%

- Artist/Producer Interviews/Q&A: 81%
- Futureproducers Newsletter: 58%
- An organized Classifieds section: 61%
- A Separate Battles Section (not in forum): 46%
- Blog Option for members: 46%



We are currently exploring the possibility of upgrading the current vBulletin forum software to version 4.0. This upgrade will incorporate the following elements.....

Anything else you'd like to add about Futureproducers.com? Open Questions had 280 replies! Some notable comments:

- Gear/brand specific forums: e.g. MPC, different DAWs
- Tapatalk support for smartphone; iPhone app
- Newsletter targeting members' interests, highlighting articles
- Ability to upload music to profile like on Soundcloud
- Add editorial content- articles, gear reviews, more stickies
- Lose the black background, very depressing
- Free download area (Freeware, and other samples, VSTs)
- Webinars on beatmaking, mixing, mastering
- Excellent survey! You are heading in the right direction!
- Differentiate users based on 'expert level'. Maybe add a 'thank you' function.
- Better search function
- Stronger moderation on 'arrogant kids' to bring back older more experienced users
- Bring gear makers or producers for Q&A
- Promote the feedback section as more people are looking for feedback than giving
- Unblock signature links to guests
- Embedding soundcloud players
